About the District

The Depew Union Free School District has a total enrollment of around 1,875 students and an organizational staff of 350. The district is comprised of one elementary school (K-5), one middle school (6-8) and a comprehensive high school (9-12).

The district was one of 44 districts statewide awarded the Stronger Connections Grant. The middle school has been recognized by the State Education Department as a leader in middle level education.

Cayuga Heights Elementary School was certified as a Leader in Me Lighthouse School by FranklinCovey Education. The high school is implementing innovative programs in Business and Technology such as "Project Lead the Way" and the Academy of Finance. The Depew Union Free School District is proud of the progress we have made in implementing the standards and helping our students prepare for life in the 21st Century.



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The Community

Depew is the proud home to 15,178 residents and many small and large businesses. This historic village, incorporated in 1894 as a railroad town, is one of the largest villages in Western New York. It is situated just 10 miles east of the City of Buffalo.

The district is located in a suburban community, ideally situated in very close proximity to all the cultural and recreational destinations of Buffalo, Niagara Falls and southern Ontario. The District is also in very close proximity to many outstanding colleges and universities including the University at Buffalo, Canisius College, Buffalo State College and Niagara University.

The District Budget

The 2023-2024 budget is \$51,542,003. Local tax base through the tax levy supports 38.51% of the school district budget, with the district receiving \$25,856,394 of its funds from state aid. The tax levy increase has averaged 2.10% over the past five years. The Depew community has strongly supported the district's budget by approving budgets each year over a more than 20-year period of time. The 2023-2024 budget had a passing percentage of 69%.

Board of Education

A seven-member Board of Education oversees the operations of the Depew Union Free School District. Members of the Board are elected to serve three-year terms of office. The Board of Education meetings are held once a month. Board members are:
