Under the instruction of Tina Fago, Peter has learned about cakes and icings, sugar and confectionary techniques, artisan breads and more.

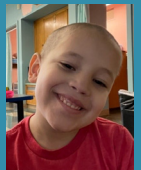
"Peter is an attentive, compassionate and hardworking student," Fago said. "He goes above and beyond to aid his fellow classmates and he always has a positive attitude."
