Under the instruction of Thomas Wood, Brandon has learned about potable water systems, soldering and brazing, central air conditioning systems, and more.

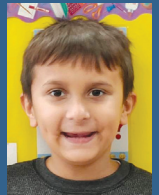
"Brandon has become extremely motivated to learn the trade. He has completed all work on time, if not early," said Wood. "He has also been helpful with his fellow students."
