

Erie 1 BOCES Educational Foundation Scholarship Sponsored by the Amherst Federal Credit Union

For the 2022 calendar year, a scholarship of \$750 each will be awarded to two Erie 1 BOCES students who meet the following criteria:

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant must be enrolled in an Erie 1 BOCES program for the 2021-22 school year
The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a student completing his/her final year of eligibility as a NYS K-12 student
The applicant must plan to attend an accredited two or four- year college or approved trade school
The successful applicant must be currently enrolled or agree to enroll as a member of the Amherst Federal Credit Union

Application Requirements

Completed, signed and submitted application form with necessary attachments on or before the listed deadline of April 15, 2022
Essay of 250 words or less describing the valuable skills you acquired with the Erie 1 BOCES program in which you participated and how this will help you with your future career plans
Two letters of reference are needed; one must be from an Erie 1 BOCES teacher and the second may be from a home school district or Erie 1 BOCES teacher, counselor or administrator indicating why you would be a worthy recipient of this scholarship

Application Procedure

The application requirements must be completed in full and postmarked/emailed by April 15, 2022, in order to be considered

Selection/Award Process

Applications will be reviewed by board members of the Erie 1 BOCES Educational Foundation, Inc. with input from Erie 1 BOCES staff, as applicable
Scholarship winners will be notified by May 1, 2022
Scholarship checks will be made payable to the college, university or approved trade school the award-winner is attending in the fall of 2022.
Award winners must provide the name and address of the attending institution prior to September 1, 2022
