Dear Families and Staff of the Northtowns Academy:

The health and safety of our students and staff is our top priority. With that in mind, the purpose of this letter is to inform you that an individual that was present in one of our programs at the Northtowns Academy on November 9th has tested positive for COVID-19. Please be aware that we cannot release the name or any personally identifiable information regarding this individual. Your receipt of this notice alone DOES NOT mean that you and/or your child have been exposed to or have come in close or proximate contact with the individual who has tested positive.

The local department of health has taken steps to notify those determined to be close and proximate contacts. Our school will remain open. Unless you were notified otherwise, you should continue to follow your class schedule.

We will provide further updates if additional steps need to be taken by our program. Please continue to monitor your child or self for symptoms and stay home if they/you are sick. In addition, please contact their/your healthcare provider if they/you develop symptoms or if you have any additional questions or concerns.
