



## Workforce Development *Student Scholarship*

In Partnership with the Amherst Federal Credit Union and the Erie 1 BOCES Educational Foundation

**Note: To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be members of, or be willing to join, the Amherst Federal Credit Union. For details, contact Kim Tomaszewski at (716) 821-7398.**

The Amherst Federal Credit Union has partnered with the Erie 1 BOCES Educational Foundation and Workforce Development to provide low-income students greater access to quality, adult education programs by offering scholarships of up to \$600 per eligible and approved student.

Eligible students must demonstrate financial need, become members of the AFCU, and enroll in a full-time Workforce Development program. A full-time program is defined as a program greater than 100 clock hours in length. Scholarship applications will be reviewed in the order in which they are received. Scholarships will be applied only *after* all other sources of grants or sponsorships have been applied.

**To qualify for the scholarship, students must complete all three (3) steps outlined below:**

- 1) Register for and be accepted into one of Erie 1 BOCES' full-time programs.
