

<p>Masks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required indoors for staff and students. • Recommended when outdoors. • Mask breaks during lunch and 5 min., every hr. • Mask exemptions per ADA. 	<p>Physical Distancing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aiming for 3ft between students. • 6ft between staff. • Virtual faculty meetings.
<p>Daily Health Screening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will have a temperature scan upon entry to the building and should health screen at home. • Staff will complete a daily health screening electronically before entering the school. 	<p>Personal Hygiene</p> <p>Students and staff are encouraged to properly wash their hands throughout the day. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes are readily available for all.</p>
<p>COVID-19 Testing</p> <p>Voluntary testing is available for asymptomatic staff and students. Visit www.e1b.org/covid for information.</p>	<p>COVID-19 Vaccinations</p> <p>Vaccinations are recommended for all eligible individuals as a means of ensuring a safe and continuous educational program.</p>
<p>Cohorts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elementary levels will use cohorts when possible. • Middle and high school levels will typically use period scheduling. 	<p>Transportation</p> <p>Transportation is the responsibility of the home school district.</p>
<p>Quarantine</p> <p>E1B will work with ECDOH to determine close contacts for quarantine purposes.</p> <p><u>*Asymptomatic, vaccinated individuals are not subject to quarantine but must mask indoors for 14 days after exposure or until negative test results.</u></p> <p><u>Unvaccinated staff and students</u> may be subject to quarantine if exposed to a positive individual within 6 ft for 15 minutes over 24-hours.</p> <p>Unvaccinated students only may be exempt from quarantine if both the student and the infected individual were engaged in consistent and current use of masking.</p> <p>Seating charts will be maintained for tracing purposes.</p> <p>Options for remote learning will be provided to students placed in quarantine. For tech support, parents should email istech@e1b.org.</p>	<p>Returning to School Following Illness</p> <p><u>Returning from COVID-19-Like Illness:</u> One of the following must be met for individuals to return following new illness, regardless of vaccination:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A negative COVID-19 test. 2. A note from a medical professional with an alternative diagnosis. 3. There have been at least 10 days since the onset of COVID-19 symptoms. <p><u>Returning from COVID-19 Positive Case:</u> All criteria must be met to return to school following testing positive for COVID-19:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 10 days after symptom onset or 10 days from the first positive test and, 2. Fever-free for at least 24 hours without medicine. 3. COVID-19 symptoms are improving. <p><i>At-home COVID-19 tests are not acceptable.</i></p>
<p>Cleaning and Disinfection</p> <p>All classrooms and buildings will be cleaned each day. High touch areas will be disinfected more frequently.</p>	<p>Ventilation</p> <p>Schools will follow all current ventilation protocols including mechanical and natural ventilation where appropriate.</p>
