National Technical Honor Society

NTHS was established to honor excellence in Career and Technical Education programs. To be considered, students must demonstrate scholastic achievement and skill development in the following ways:

- Good Character, Leadership, Honor and Responsibility
- Maintain 90% Average in CTE program, 85% Average in District
- Maintain 95% Attendance
- Submission of Membership Application, Portfolio, and 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Personal Interview

Regents Diploma with a Technical Endorsement

The Technical Endorsement Seal is affixed to the high school diploma of students who complete a 2-year NYS approved Career and Technical program and meet the following requirements:

- Passing 5 required Regents exams
- Successful completion of a 3-part Technical Assessment
- Completion of work-based learning experiences
- Completion of a work-skills employability profile

Completion with Honors

A seal of Completion with Honors is affixed to the diploma of students who complete a CTE program and develop essential skills for college and the workplace.

- Completion of All Program Requirements
- Minimum 90% Program Average
- Good Attendance (no more than 10 days absent per year)
- Punctuality (no more than 10 days late per year)
- Minimum Score of 90% on Career Portfolio
- Successful Participation in a Program Internship
